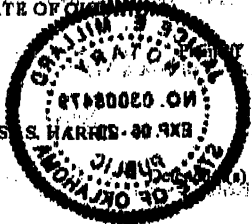

**AFFIDAVIT**

STATE OF OKLAHOMA

COUNTY OF TULSA

The undersigned, of lawful age, being duly sworn, upon oath deposes and states as follows:

- 1. He is a City of Tulsa police officer assigned to Detective Division.
- 2. He has read certain official investigative reports and statements of witnesses regarding the above named Defendant(s) and from these reports it appears as follows:

On 03/09/2008 the victims, hereafter referred to as victim one (wf, age 32) and victim two (wf, age 38), were at the Extended Stay motel at 8201 E. Skelly Drive within the city and county of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Victim one had a prior relationship with the defendant. Earlier in the morning she called him asking for legal advice reference victim two. The defendant told her that he would call her back at a later time.

Victim one stated that at approximately 1100 hours the defendant drove up in the parking lot outside of her motel room and they engaged in a conversation. She stated that the defendant asked her questions about victim two's appearance and suggested that the three of them engage in group sex. Victim one stated that the defendant was sitting in his car during the conversation rubbing his penis through his pants, and that he asked her if she missed his penis (referring to it by a pet name they shared). Victim one stated that defendant exited the car and exposed his penis through the fly of his trousers. Victim one stated that the defendant continued speaking to her as he masturbated his semi-turgid penis.

Victim two exited the motel room at this point and approached the vehicle. The defendant turned towards victim two, exposing his penis to her as he continued speaking to victim one. After a few seconds he replaced his penis within his trousers. Victim two was able to describe that defendant's penis is uncircumcized, which the defendant later confirmed.

Victim one and victim two went back to their motel room at this point and the defendant left the scene.

During non-custodial interviews the defendant placed himself at the scene and confirmed that he had a conversation with the victims, but denies any exposure or illicit sexual conversation.

A cleaning lady employed by the motel, who was working nearby, confirms having observed a subject matching the defendant's description, driving a vehicle matching a vehicle he owns to be holding a conversation in the parking lot with the victims. The witness did not observe the exposure or hear the conversation.

Wherefore, affiant prays this Honorable Court to issue a warrant for the within named Defendant(s), that he/she/they may be brought before and held to answer for the offense(s) of
